Brief Description:

A Youth Volunteer Cat Socializer assists with cat socialization in the cat colony room. This is a fun and rewarding position in which the youth volunteer helps prepare cats and kittens for adoption. Playtime and petting greatly improve a feline's relationships and interactions with people and potential adopters. A volunteer in this position must be comfortable with cats and have a basic knowledge of handling and care of felines.

Responsibilities:

- Meet Mission & Vision of Tulsa SPCA.
- Comply with all Tulsa SPCA policies and procedures, including a high standard of dependability for promptness and attendance.
- Assist with preparing shelter cats for adoption and integration into their new home.
- Assist with socialization of cats and kittens.
- Assist with non-chemical related cleaning duties, such as scooping litter boxes and filling food and water bowls.
- Completing other duties as assigned

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 9 years of age.
- Must have parent or guardian with them during all volunteer shifts if they are under the age of 16.
- Must be comfortable with felines.
- Must have the ability to react appropriately to non-socialized cats.
- Must complete Cat 101 training.
